Cook-off Rules

1. **Preparing of food has to be done at the festival grounds on cook-off day.**
2. **A team may consist of no more than four (4) cooks.**
3. **One team member must remain in the cooking area at all times.**
4. **Cook-off sites will be given to each team in order of entry fee received.**
5. **Ingredients for each entry are up to the team members; no restrictions of ingredients.**
6. **All cooking materials must be provided by each team.**
7. **No alcoholic beverages, sodas, or waters will be allowed to be brought into the festival grounds. Only items needed to prepare food.**
8. **Bowls and foil will be provided by the committee with ticket number attached to the bottom of each entry.**
9. **Friday – Beans need to be turned in at 4:00 pm
Ribs need to be turned in at 5:00 pm**
10. **Saturday - The Vaquero Showmanship will be at 2:00 pm
Pan de Campo needs to be turned in at 3:00 pm
Dessert Specialty Dish needs to be turned in at 4:00 pm
Brisket needs to be turned in at 5:00 pm**
11. **The Dessert Specialty Dish can be any kind of dessert, as long as it is cooked at the cooking site. It can be cooked on open fire, Dutch oven or barbeque pit. Be creative and have fun with it.**
12. **Please practice safe food handling procedures and fire safety.**
13. **Each team must have a fire extinguisher at cooking site.**
14. **Cooking teams need to provide their own canopy or tent.**
15. **Head Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his/her team and in keeping the area clean.**
16. **No vulgar or inappropriate team shirts or displays.**
17. **Last but not least, and the most important rule is to have fun and spread the love and joy of Vaquero cooking.**

***The Vaquero Association or members are not liable for any accidents or damage incurred during the cook-off. Nor are we liable for any food sicknesses that may occur during visitor tastings.**

***If rules are not obeyed, violators will be disqualified.**
